

## Example case 1

(The prescribed remedy is not shown in order not to distract the reader from studying the way how the information itself is presented)

### **30/08/2007: new patient**

Since three days a five-year-old boy has a fever of more then 39 °C [3]. He is getting sicker and sicker since today.

His tongue is coated white [3] and his palate is painful [2].

His nose is obstructed [1].

He has no thirst [3].

I observe that his face and ears are very hot and red [3] and that his feet are ice-cold [2/3]

*Prescription: Remedy 1000K*

### **31/08/2007: follow-up 1**

Within a few hours after the remedy the boys condition cleared up. The fever dropped and he started to play.

*Prescription: wait*

### **01/09/2007: follow-up 2**

All his complaints are gone and he is doing well in general.

*Prescription: wait*

### **Symptoms of the case**

01. A fever of more then 39 °C [3] → [0]
02. His tongue is coated white [3] → [0]
03. His palate is painful [2] → [0]
04. His nose is obstructed [1] → [0]
05. He has no thirst [3] → [0]
06. His face and ears are very hot and red [3] → [0]
07. His feet are ice-cold [2/3] → [0]

## Further processing by the foundation

So far the case as it could have been presented for the archive. The next step is to process these symptoms into repertory language. This is not what we ask from the homeopath sending in the case. We will do it ourselves. If, however, there are specific rubrics that the practitioner wants to emphasize concerning a case then of course he can add this information.

[NSR] = new rubric in the repertory

[NE] = new entry for this remedy in existing rubric in the repertory

GENERALS - CHILDREN; complaints in

FEVER - INTENSE heat

FEVER - INTENSE heat - children; in [NE]

MOUTH - DISCOLORATION - Tongue - white - fever; during

MOUTH - PAIN – Palate - fever; during [NSR]

NOSE - OBSTRUCTION - fever; during

STOMACH - THIRSTLESS - fever; during

STOMACH - THIRSTLESS - heat; during

FACE - DISCOLORATION - red - fever - during - agg.

EAR - DISCOLORATION - redness - fever - during - agg. [NSR]

FACE - HEAT - fever - during - agg. [NE]

EAR - HEAT - fever - during - agg. [NSR]

FACE - HEAT - cold - Feet, with

EAR - HEAT - cold - Feet, with [NSR]

EXTREMITIES - COLDNESS - Feet - fever - during - agg.
